

John Hutchins, of Ohio, in Reply to His Colleague, Mr. Cox, Delivered in the House of Representatives, Saturday, July 5, 1862 Mr. Chairman: My colleague [Mr. Cox] from the Columbus district, on the 6th of June, in Committee of the Whole, made a most extraordinary speech, intending thereby to damage the fair reputation of the Thirtyseventh Congress, whose epitaph, after a fashion, he took the pains to write out. The most cruel epitaph he could have written would have been the following, inserted at the close of his speech: This speech was listened to with patience by the House. In justice to the House, it should be stated, that during its delivery there were but few members present, and most of them his political friends. There is one other fact that it may be important to notice in connection with this speech - that it was delivered late Friday evening, and that it was distributed in pamphlet form early the next morning, and, consequently, I suppose most of it must have been in type before it was delivered, and this will account for [laughter] coming in very frequently, and at proper places. It is sometimes difficult to get the laugh in when one wants it, for it will not always come at a speakers bidding, and this mode of my colleague supplies this defect, and shows when the auditors should have laughed, if they did not. I will briefly notice some points of this carefully written out speech. I cannot consent to follow his style of argumentation, for I cannot do it without getting into the...
