With a friendly tone and a sense of humor, photographer Dan Suzio describes how he shoots the landscapes, flowers, wildlife, and ghost towns of what is perhaps America s most storied national park, addressing both the technical and creative aspects of nature photography. The book is generously illustrated with the author s photographs, each one captioned with camera, lens, exposure, and other information about how it was made. The book provides descriptions of more than sixty specific locations in and around the park, noting the photographic highlights of each one, the time of day to find the best light, and the typical wildflower season plus maps and directions to get you there. Most of the locations listed are accessible via passenger car. For the more adventurous, Suzio includes a selection of more remote places that require a fourwheel-drive vehicle, and even a few that call for an all-day hike. First-time visitors will appreciate his tips on how to stay alive in a place that holds records as the hottest, lowest, and driest place in the U.S. He also tells you where to...
