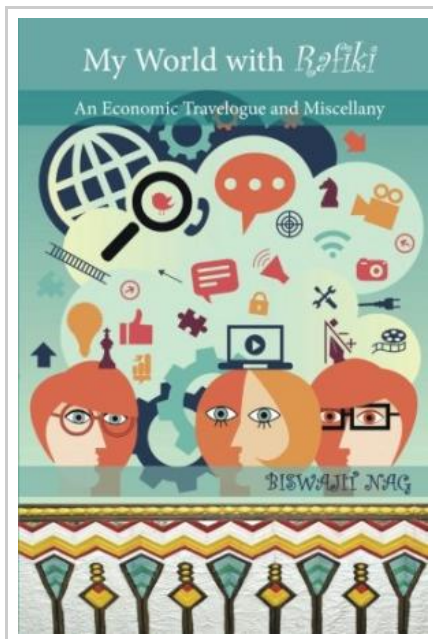




My World with Rafiki: An Economic Travelogue and Miscellany
