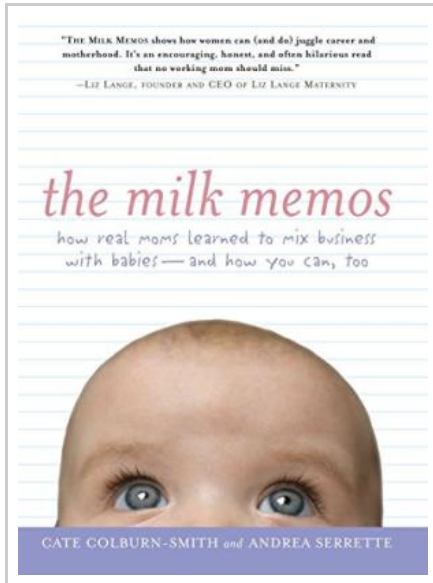




The Milk Memos: How Real Moms Learned to Mix Business with Babies - And How You Can, Too
