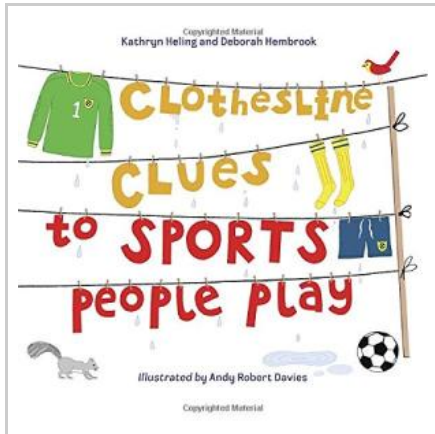




Clothesline Clues to Sports People Play (Hardback)
