Hence considerable numbers of the Poles, whose travelling expenses were paid by the committee to go to towns in the interior of the state, to Baltimore, c., in quest of employment, returned completely disappointed and disheartened. Their expenses of travelling, and those of Mr. Johnson and his companions, made a considerable inroad...
