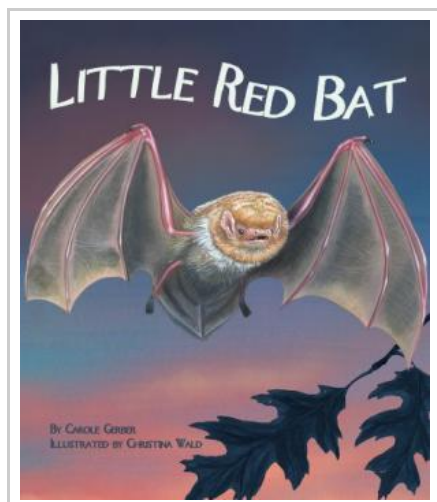




Little Red Bat
