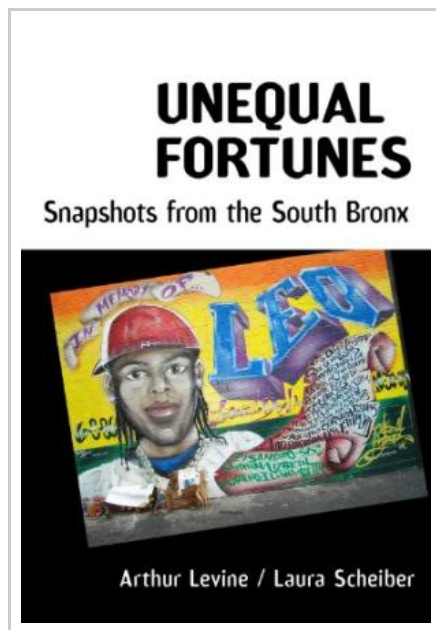




Unequal Fortunes: Snapshots from the South Bronx (Hardback)
